



Bernd Elementary Unified Dress Code



Bernd Elementary School Unified Dress for Success. Please keep this in mind when shopping for back to school clothes!

Students may wear:

- Khaki (tan or beige), black, or navy walking **shorts, slacks, jumpers, Capri pants, skirts** and **skorts**. **NO LEGGINGS**. All pants must be solid colors, non-faded, without holes or fraying, and fitted at the waist and appropriate length (cannot touch the floor). Skirts, skorts, and jumpers may be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
 - Turtle neck or collared shirts (all solid colors) with sleeves containing no designs or logos except the school logo or crest. Clothing **MUST** be the appropriate size. Non-collared Bernd spirit wear clothing may be worn.
 - Shirts must be tucked in and belts worn if there are belt loops. Socks must be worn and shoes must have toes and backs with heels no higher than 2 inches. Only students who can tie them may wear shoes with laces.
 - Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, and scarves may not be worn on the head while in the building.
 - Jeans may only be worn on announced days.
- * Jewelry must not be distracting. Large earrings are not appropriate due to activity levels at school that could cause injury to the ear. Multiple bracelets can also be a distraction.

Items not permitted in the Bibb County dress code will not be permitted in the unified dress policy at Bernd Elementary School.
